Art of the Quilt: Unfolding Our Story

Mt. Airy Art Garage Entry Requirements

Show Dates: February 28-April 25, 2014 Deadline for Submission: January 31, 2014

- Work must consist of textile or fiber layers stabilized by hand or machine stitching.
- No quilts from kits and no cheater cloth.
- Works should be original designs or interpretations of traditional patterns.
- Works made according to a pattern by a modern designer are welcome with credit to the designer.
- Collaborative work is welcome with credit given to all participants.
- Works pieced by one artist and professionally quilted by another are welcome with credit given to the quilter.
- There is no requirement relating to the date of completion of the guilt.
- Edges of the quilt must be bound or finished.
- Quilt must have a 4 inch sleeve on the back securely sewn top and bottom.
- Odd shaped quilts or quilts with multiple panels must be mounted on fabric and outfitted with a sleeve.
- Quilts must be labeled on the back with the name of the work and the artist.
- Quilts must be clean, undamaged and free of strong odors.
- Quilts of any size are welcome. Quilts longer than 72 inches may be folded over at the top for display if necessary to accommodate space restrictions.

Entry Procedure

- Entries must include completed and signed entry form along with two jpegs of each work.
- Images must be at least 1000 pixels on the longest side or at least 90 dpi.
- There will be a limit of 3 entries per person.
- Fee for members is \$15 for one entry, \$20 for two entries and \$25 for three entries.
- Fee for non-members is \$20 for one entry, \$35 for two entries and \$50 for three entries.
- Entries must be sent via email to QuiltShow.MAAG@gmail.com by January 31, 2014.
- Entrants must provide an email that will remain active for the duration of the application process and throughout the exhibition and return period. Entrants can

use a friend's email, but they must agree that emails from MAAG will be responded to within 48 hours of receipt.

• Any works accepted for exhibition must be available for display for the entire length of the exhibition.

Jurying

- Entries will be juried from digital images by a panel including quilt and textile artists.
- Entries will be evaluated based on artistic merit and craftsmanship.
- MAAG reserves the right to decline accepted works that differ dramatically from the image submitted.
- Images will not be returned.
- Artists will be notified of acceptance to the show by February 10, 2014.

Delivery and Return of Quilts

- Quilts must be delivered to MAAG no later than February 20th, 2014.
- Quilts can be delivered in person on February 15 from noon to 6 pm or on February 16 from noon to 5 pm.
- Quilts can be sent by UPS care of Linda Slodki, Attention: Homelink, 5 West Mt. Airy Ave., Philadelphia, PA 19119.
- Artists desiring return of their artwork by UPS must send a prepaid air bill for return. Quilts will be returned in original packaging.

Sale of Works

- Artists are encouraged to offer their work for sale. A limited number of quilts will be accepted that are not for sale.
- Artists are responsible for establishing the sale price for their work.
- MAAG will take 30% of the sales price as commission for the gallery.
