Submissions will be juried. We will notify you if your work has been accepted Sat., June 1, 2019.

In celebration of the 50th Anniversary of Stonewall, the Mayor's Office of LGBT Affairs, Philadelphia Family Pride, and the Mt. Airy Art Garage have partnered yet again for the second year of the Philly Family Pride Picnic & Arts Festival. This event will have family-specific entertainment, fine art and handcraft, music, food, and resource tables from a variety of organizations and nonprofits that provide services and support to LGBTQ families and youth.

All artists are invited to submit your work for sale. All work must be your own original work. Anything you submit must reflect what has been juried (no add-ons). The cost for the day, which includes a 10'x10' space, is \$75/members and \$100/nonmembers. There is a \$15 Jury Fee for this event that is non-refundable, as well as a \$3 fee if you pay online with PayPal. The artists retain 100% of their sales when selling during the Art Markets. Artists are responsible for tables, chairs, and tent setups. No electricity is available.

- All works of art must reflect the type of work submitted in your application. No add-ons.
- All artwork must remain on display for the duration of the Art Festival, and all artists must remain with their work.
- Artists must bring their own tents, tables, chairs, displays, supports, etc. whatever is needed for their presentation. **No electricity is available.**
- To be considered, artists must provide all the following: **submission forms with payment, artist bio/statement & JPEGs.**
- If work is not accepted, table fee will be refunded.
